



Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Local Safeguarding Children Boards' Safer Sleeping Campaign

Sadly, over the last eighteen months, across Peterborough and Cambridgeshire, there have been seven recorded infant deaths where parents had been co-sleeping with their babies. These infant deaths could have been prevented.

Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Local Safeguarding Children Boards in partnership with the Designated Doctor for Deaths in Childhood and Health Visitor Safeguarding Leads, are launching a 'Safe Sleeping Campaign' to promote awareness to professionals and parents about safer sleeping with babies.

For Professionals, across the region, listed below are Local Practice Groups, which will provide workshops on safer sleeping and materials for making Mums and Dads aware of the risks of sleeping with babies, if they :-

- Smoke
- Drink alcohol and / or take drugs
- Are taking medication
- Place their baby in an unsafe environment
